Visit from Aberdeen PS

Welcome: The secretary welcomed the members and visiting speakers – Fred and Chrissie Jefferies from Aberdeen PS. Vice President, Francis Podger, apologised for not being present at the start due to travel arrangements.

Displays:

Fred Jefferies displayed mail sent from Germany showing many varieties of covers including zeppelin and catapult mail as well as a wartime security chemically tested letter. Chrissie Jefferies' display was a themed one on the circus. This included stamps, covers, cards and ephemera such as match box covers, cigarette cards, programmes and scrap-books as well as a selection of large advertising posters.
