


Webmaster's Report

In the previous 12 months no significant changes have been made to the website other than the normal updates as a result of society meetings and updates to the exhibition schedule.

One feature which has taken off is the ability to publish member's displays. One of our members has provided a number of displays to be published and these will appear on the site in due course.

Work has commenced on a complete revision of the website to improve its functionality and to include a private members' area which will include access to a library database for members to enquire upon all books held in our Library. It is hoped that at some point during our summer recess this new site will start to become available to members, but it may take slightly longer for the library facility to become available for use as it will take time to populate the database with the details of the books.

Usage of our current website continues to be healthy as can be seen from the graphs below which show that on average our website receives 16 new visitors every month. Indeed I am pleased to report that this year as a society our membership increased by 1 as a result of the new member viewing our website.



The analysis of operating systems used by visitors to the site shows a consistent use of the Windows Operating System as the major tool for accessing the website, but also a gradual increase in the use of the Android operating system for mobile access and the MacIntosh OS, as well as stability in the numbers using the IOS operating system.

Finally, I would like to ensure that our website is still an evolving website, so I would ask members to give consideration to any features that they would like to see available on the website and discuss this with me, whereupon I investigate how their request can be fulfilled.
